A Lovely Dwelling Place

How lovely is Your dwelling place,
O LORD of hosts!

My soul longs, yes, faints for the courts of the LORD;

We should long to be present with the Lord in His house. May that longing for His dwelling place cause us to commit ourselves to the place where His Spirit dwells in the church of Jesus Christ.


