## From Pastor Dave: Doctrine of Bible (Bibliology)

This is month two of looking at the doctrines of the Christian faith. Last month we looked at the doctrine of revelation. God in his grace and mercy chose to reveal himself to us. He revealed himself in general ways and specific ways (see last months' newsletter). One of the specific ways that God reveals himself is through the Bible. Studying and understanding the Bible therefore, is really important, because it one of the ways that God reveals himself. So what does the doctrine of the Bible state?

### Bibliology

God uses scripture to reveal Himself. The Bible is authoritative because of divine inspiration (2 Tim. 3:16). The Greek word for inspiration is *theopneustos*. This literally means "inspired" or "breathed out" by God. It is the act of God's instilling into the biblical authors that which He wanted communicated. God worked through the Holy Spirit to enable the authors of the scriptures to record God's words without error and without destroying the unique personalities of the authors (2 Pet. 1:21). The Bible is divinely illuminated (Jn. 16:13, 14), meaning the Holy Spirit is able to work within the heart and the mind of the believer to allow understanding in what has been written in the scriptures. The Bible is "God breathed" (2 Tim. 3:16) and infallible (Ps. 19:7) in its nature.

God preserved His word through the early church. The early church compiled and canonized scripture. The Bible, as we have it today, consists of the 39 books of the Hebrew canon and the 27 books of the New Testament canon. Each of the books in the Bible were tested before they were included in the canon. These tests included: the verification of the author as a prophet, Jesus' recognition of the Hebrew canon, and the apostolic authorship and acceptance by the universal church.

### Summary

When we read the Bible we read God's very words. If you ever want to hear God speak to you, read your Bible. Not only did God inspire the authors of scripture to record his words for us, but through the Holy Spirit our minds are illuminated to understand the things that God had them record. Because God is perfect in nature, His words are perfect in nature. What we have in the Bible is what God desired us to have.

One of the amazing things about the Bible is that it was written over a 1,500 year time period by 40 different authors. What is even more amazing is that is that given the time period that it was written over and the number of authors God used to write it, it is internally consistent throughout. The message in Genesis is the same message in Revelation. The early church fathers spent a lot of time and effort looking at the different books and letters to evaluate whether they were to be included in the Canon of Scripture. They tested them, they prayed over them and what we have today we can be confident is what God desired to be passed down to his church for the generations to come.
